A PRAYER FROM TITUS 3:3-7 PASSAGE

“Dear God, I confess and believe, that ‘3 At one time I too was foolish, disobedient, deceived and enslaved by all kinds of passions and pleasures. I lived in malice and envy, being hated and hating one another. 4 But when the kindness and love of God our Savior appeared, 5

YOU saved me, not because of righteous things I had done, but because of YOUR mercy. YOU saved me through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, 6 whom YOU poured out on me generously through Jesus Christ our Savior, 7 so that, having been justified by YOUR grace, I might become an heir, having the hope of eternal life.’

- As far as the age for taking communion, a person should take communion who is old enough and is able to “examine themselves” and able to “discern” and “judge themselves” (from 1 Corinthians 11:27-32). With this guidance we encourage parents give instruction to their children about taking or not taking the communion bread and grape juice.
- The bags of grapes are understood as invitations, as Jesus said, “Let the little children come to me” (from Mark 10:13-16).
