## GIVING AT THE TABER EMC CHURCH

Thank you for your faithfulness in giving to the church. Your monetary gift allows us to continue our Ministry to God's people. If you have any questions about tithing, we encourage you to connect with our Treasurers, Margaret Wiebe and Elly Ruggles.

There are 3 ways to tithe,

1. You may place a cash donation for the amount you feel led to give into the offering bags that are sent around during the Sunday morning worship services. This tithing is kept personal and there is no record of it other than it is added to our offering totals.
2. You may also donate with a Donation ID Number which allows our treasurers to keep a record of your donations and then you are given a receipt at the end of the year to use for your government tax claim. Your donation is kept confidential and only our treasurers keep a record using your ID Number.
3. E-transfers is a great option for donating to the church if you're someone that no longer use cheques or carries cash. It's as simple as logging in to your online banking and sending your offering through regular e-transfer. Our account is now set up for e-transfers to be auto-deposited so you won't need to use a security question. There are flyers at the back of the church with all the details or please connect with our Treasurers with any questions you might have.

Any donations of \$200 or less in one year allow you a 25% benefit to your government tax claim, meaning for every dollar you donated, 25¢ is returned. Any donations over \$200 in one year allow you a 50% benefit to your tax return, meaning for every dollar you donated, 50¢ is returned.
